CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE Bonsall Union School District August 19, 2008

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000 et seq, requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") has adopted a regulation, California Code of Regulations, Title 2, division 6, Section 18730 (hereinafter "CCR 18730"), which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. It can be incorporated by reference and may be amended by the FPPC after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of CCR 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the FPPC are hereby incorporated by reference and along with the attached Appendix in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth constitute the conflict of interest code of the Bonsall Union School District.

Designated employees shall file statements of economic interests with the agency. Upon receipt of the statements of the Directors, the agency shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of these statements to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors. The original statements for all other designated employees will be retained by the agency.

Consultants shall be included in the list of Designated Employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in this Code subject to the following limitation:

Disclosure for designated employees pursuant to Schedule E, Gifts, shall be limited to gifts with a value of \$50 or more received from persons doing business with the Bonsall Union School District.

¹The Superintendent may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that are limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based on that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Superintendent's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
