

NAME: **INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

LEGAL AUTHORITY: County Administrative Code, Article XII-E, commencing with Section 204 through 204.10 relating to the Pesticide Task Force amended 11/1/94 (35); amended 4/4/95 (41); amended 7/23/08(27); Ordinance 9951 (N.S.).

MEMBERS

APPOINTED BY: Nominated by the Board Chair and appointed by the Board of Supervisors to fill the first nine positions. The ad hoc members shall be appointed by the Agricultural Commissioner.

MEMBERSHIP

COMPOSITION: The Integrated Pest Management Committee shall represent a cross section of organizations and groups involved in pesticide management as follows:

Toxicologist - 1 member

Occupational Health Physician - 1 member

Farm Bureau nominee - 1 member

Attorney having environmental law expertise - 1 member

Environmental group representative - 1 member

Entomologist with integrated pest management background
- 1 member

Organic growing specialist - 1 member

Public representative - 1 member

Licensed structural pest control operator - 1 member

Ad hoc members from appropriate County departments as determined by the Agricultural Commissioner.

TERMS: Members appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall serve a term of office for two years, or until the committee is dissolved by Board action, whichever occurs first. Members appointed by the Agricultural Commissioner shall serve when needed as determined by the Agricultural Commissioner.

DUTIES:

The Integrated Pest Management Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

To advise and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors on matters pertaining to sound, environmentally safe pest management practices.

To make recommendations to those departments using pesticides.

Upon request, work with the Agricultural Commissioner on resolving certain identified agricultural/urban related issues that occur.

Respond to any other items that may be assigned to the Committee by the Board of Supervisors.
