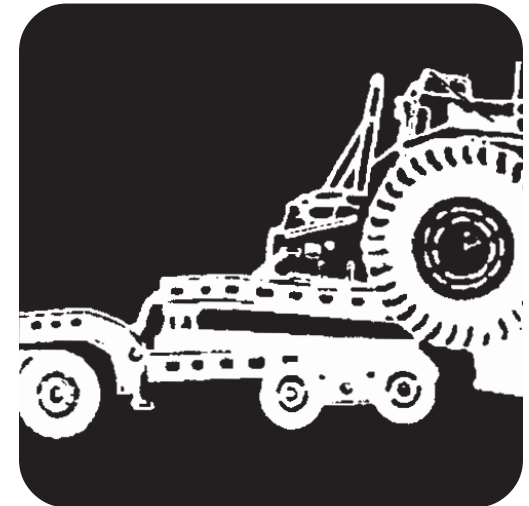


- The permitted route must be followed except in emergencies.
- All extensions must be properly flagged and any detached objects must be secured.
- Moving period shall be from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm unless very unusual conditions warrant granting the permit at other times. No moving is allowed on Saturdays, Sundays or legal holidays unless stated on permit.
- Warning: No convoys of structures shall be permitted.
- Arrangements for tree trimming or removal of structures within the right-of-way shall be prior to move.
- A pilot car must accompany any structure over 12'6" in width and two pilot cars are required for any structure over 14' in width. Pilot car(s) will be required for any height, weight, length, or roads at the discretion of this department, I.E., based on an analysis of the lane width and/or alignment of the roadway. Pilot cars must conform to legal specifications which are available from Public Works.
- The mover is responsible for all requirements and conditions of the permit.

REQUIREMENTS For a Single Trip Moving Permit Moving Equipment, Building, Mobilehome or Structure?

A moving permit is required for moving any extra-legal load which is over-weight and/or oversized on any County road.

(A legal load is a maximum of 8' wide, 13'6" high and 40' long). Moving permit applications must be submitted at least 48 hours prior to moving any structure or equipment.

Moves are 9:00 am – 4:00 pm unless otherwise specified.

NOTE:

Loads over 16' wide and/or 17' high may require route evaluations prior to issuance of the permit. These applications must be submitted to the Department of Public Works at least eight days prior to intended move. A \$235.00 route evaluation deposit is required. All other moving permits can usually be issued over the counter.

The mover is responsible for checking the route prior to the move of the structure, equipment, or mobile home.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- \$16.00 permit fee (checks Payable to "County of San Diego")
- Contractor must also provide:
A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE for Auto Liability (\$500,000 minimum), naming County of San Diego Department of Public Works as CERTIFICATE HOLDER.
- # of axles, # of tires, axle spacing and axle width
- Approximate weight of load
- Exact point of origin and destination
- Route to be followed over County roads
- Date of move
- The number of sections in which the building or structure will be moved
- Type and number of conveyances
- Type of transporting units and weight distribution by axle required if over legal weight limitation
- Time of move
- Security deposits as required.

Warning: Proof of valid building permit for placing a building, including mobile homes, on a site located within the unincorporated portion of the County is required prior to issuance of a moving permit.

REQUIREMENTS For Obtaining a Blanket Permit

A yearly blanket permit may be obtained by customers who move buildings or structures and equipment on a regular basis. Applicants would submit a \$90.00 permit fee along with the above information to the Construction/Road Right-of-Way Counter.

Hours of Moves are Sunrise to Sunset, per C.V.C. 280, 'Darkness'.*

Legal dimensions for a blanket permit shall not exceed the following measurements:

EQUIPMENT (Includes Saturday/Sunday)

Height – 15' Overall

Width – 13' 6" Overall

Length – 90' (5 Axle);

– 110' (7 or 9 Axle) Overall

* 10' wide x 90' or 110' long unladen valid
24 hours

BUILDING/STRUCTURE

Height – 15' Overall

Width – 12' Overall

Length – 90' Overall
