R U ready to “Election Up”? A Statewide Special Election was recently announced for Tuesday, May 19, 2009 so once again the Registrar of Voters is in election mode and preparing for another success. For this election we still need a few more committed individuals like you to serve alongside a few thousand of your fellow citizens who have already committed to serving their community as a poll worker on this long (5:30 am to 10 pm) but rewarding day.

So, why “election up” and be a poll worker? It is unique and meaningful volunteerism that fulfills perhaps the most fundamental but vital role in the democratic process – helping fellow citizens exercise their voting rights. You’ll meet new people, receive elections training, and even earn a little extra money. The stipends range from \$75 to \$150 depending on your assignment. Bilingual poll workers in Spanish, Filipino, or Vietnamese serving at a poll assigned with language assistance will receive an additional \$15.
