NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION September 17, 2009

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the County of San Diego, Department of Parks and Recreation, as lead agency, is circulating for public review a Draft Negative Declaration (ND) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the proposed Collier Park Soccer Arena project.

Project Title: Collier Park Soccer Arena

Project Location: Collier County Park, 626 E Street, Ramona, CA 92065

Project Description: The proposed project consists of the installation of an outdoor soccer arena facility for community youth and adult recreational programs. The proposed soccer arena will include an artificial turf field, arena walls and perimeter fencing/netting. Outdoor lighting will be installed around the arena for night-time use, along with a lighted scoreboard. Other facility amenities will include player seating, two bleacher areas for spectators, and walkways that will connect the arena to the existing park. In addition, if funding is available, the project also proposes to refurbish an existing tennis court for use as a basketball court.
