SAN LUIS REY RIVER PARK MASTER PLAN UPDATE

To: All parties and individuals interested in the River Park Master Plan

Since the last update, DPR and CALTRANS have continued meeting on issues important to both agencies regarding the "middle" SR-76 project and the Master Plan for the San Luis Rey River Park. As the SR-76 realignment project moves forward, it continues to be County Parks and Recreation intent to make sure that the River Park Master Plan compliments what CALTRANS does with SR-76 and in doing so minimize potential impacts to either agency's project schedule.

CALTRANS released their EIR/ EIS for the SR-76 "middle" project in October. County Parks and Recreation was invited to have a table at the CALTRANS' public meeting held at the Bonsall Community Center on November 14th, where Parks and Recreation personnel answered questions regarding the San Luis Rey River Park Master Plan.

County Parks and Recreation's PEIR that needs to be certified along with the San Luis Rey River Park Master Plan continues to be worked on with a public review period planned for the February to March 2008 timeframe. During public review, a County Parks and Recreation meeting, similar to the one held by CALTRANS, will be held to present and discuss the PEIR. From late Summer 2008 to early Fall 2008, Parks and Recreation will request County Board of Supervisors to certify the final Environmental Impact Report and Master Plan.
