

Survey Results

Tijuana River Valley Regional Park Active Recreation Area - Concept Plan Development

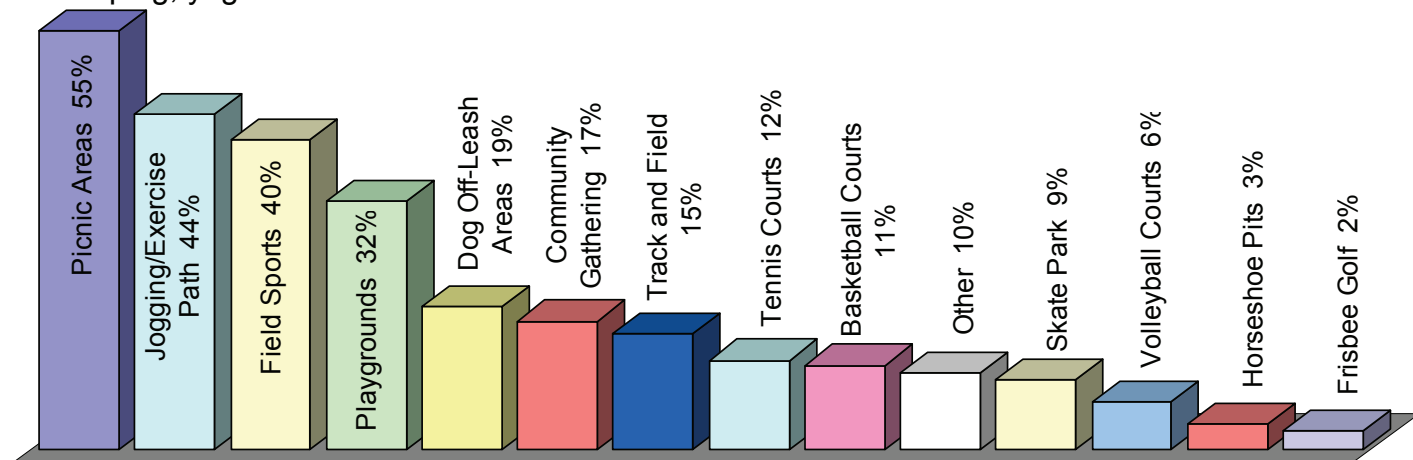
The public input survey was the first part of the public outreach that the County is performing to get an idea of what activities park users would like to see in the concept plan. The survey was mailed out to all 20,000 households within a two-mile radius. A total of 1,645 responses were received. Here is a summary of the feedback. Thanks for your help!

How would you use the park once built?

- 55% would use the park one to two times per week.
- Around 40% are currently involved with organized sports (Soccer 64%, Baseball/Softball 44%, Football 22%, Tennis 12%, Other 22%)*.
- 62% would use the park for tournaments and league play.
- 60% would use the park in the evening.

What Activities would attract you?

- Picnic areas, community areas, playgrounds and sports fields were selected as the amenities that would most attract potential users.
- “Other” activities made up about 10% of the responses*. Items that were listed multiple times included: Swimming and water aerobics, racquetball, bicycle areas, horse trails/ horse riding, camping, yoga.



*Survey respondents could select multiple activities, so percentages may add up to more than 100%.
