Applicants are placed on a waiting list and preference is given to extremely low income households with at least one family member having an AIDS diagnosis. Medical and Income eligibility are verified when applicants are pulled from the waiting list.

Short Term Rent, Mortgage and Utility (STRMU) Assistance
