

Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968 (Fair Housing Act), as amended, prohibits discrimination in the sale, rental, and financing of dwellings, and in other housing-related transactions, based on race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status (including children under the age of 18 living with parents or legal custodians, pregnant women, and people securing custody of children under the age of 18), and handicap (disability).

Advertising of Available Units

The Housing Authority maintains a listing of rental units available to Section 8 families. Landlords can place their unit information by contacting the Housing Authority at (858) 694-4801. It takes approximately one week for the information to be placed in the listing.

Housing Quality Standards

Housing quality standards (HQS) are minimum nationwide standards that apply to all units in the Section 8 program. HQS helps to ensure that the unit is decent, safe and sanitary.
